Female and male judoka with intellectual disability of levels I / II / III with a valid sports health certificate.

## **Classification:**

**Level 1:** Motoric strong skilled ID-Judoka (inconspicuous movement behaviour)

**Level 2:** Motoric limited skilled ID-Judoka (conspicuous movement behaviour)

**Level 3:** only for judoka with Down Syndrom.

Classification will be done after a divisioning.

## **Please note:**

- ALL COMPETITION WILL START IN TACHI-WAZA (STANDING POSITION)
- Any person who needs additional requirements in addition to an intellectual disability is not eligible to participate if it harms your health or involves unfair disadvantages for the opponent. For example artificial joints, heart pacemakers etc. (see also INAS criteria)
- No judoka can become champion without a fight.

### **1. Registration form for the athletes**

All judoka already registered on the INAS Master List are eligible to start, please indicate registration number when registering.

- 1.1 Unregistered athletes must apply for registration through the National Eligibility Official (NEO) using the INAS V8 form

## **INAS criteria**

Persons who, in addition to their disability, suffer from diseases that can be aggravated by competitive sports are excluded from participation. Among other things this usually applies to persons who have implants (e.g. artificial joints, pacemakers etc.) or have survived a heart attack.

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The organizer reserves the right to merge weight categories if the number of participants is insufficient.

**Number of mats 1** (depending on number of participants)

- All national federations and their participants accept the „International Contest Rules and Guidelines ID-Judo“ when registering.
- Every national federation will delegate (**if possible**) a referee with experience in ID-judo
- All athletes must wear white judogi and are requested to provide their own blue and white belts. No graduation belts can be worn when fighting.

#### **Insurance**

For each athlete an accident and health insurance as well as a liability insurance is needed. The **organization doesn't accept responsibility!**

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## Doping

*Doping is prohibited under the terms of the German Disabled Sports Association e.V. (DBS - NPC). Valid is the anti-doping code of the DBS and the rules of WADA, the IPC, the NADA and, at international events, that of the relevant International Sports Association.*

*By submitting the entry of the event, the athlete, represented by his supervisor, recognizes the anti-doping regulations in their currently valid version (available at [www.dbs-npc.de](http://www.dbs-npc.de)).*

*Doping controls are initiated by the Anti-Doping Officer of the DBS and can be carried out randomly. The taking or carrying of drugs that are on the current WADA Prohibited List is prohibited; in the case of violation, the absolute personal responsibility applies. However, if, for therapeutic reasons, medicines must be taken that are on the current WADA Prohibited List, written evidence at the doping control must be provided:*

*presentation of a proof with medically prescribed drugs and their ingestion (medical certificate with diagnosis (es) in copy not older than 12 months!),*

*for athletes in the NADA test pool (ATP, NTP or RTP), the following applies: the ingestion of banned but therapeutically necessary drugs must be documented by means of a special license (TUE).*

*If this proof of indication is missing, a legal procedure of the DBS legal committee will be initiated if the result of the doping test is positive and the athlete must expect appropriate sanctions for doping offenses. You can also check the drug's drug-related relevance online at [www.nadamed.de](http://www.nadamed.de) yourself. *Medicine. If in doubt, please contact the Department of Medicine / Anti-Doping in the DBS.*

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Registrations are only possible for INAS registered ID-judoka according to the Paralympic regulations.
